

Eleventh Supplemental Agreement

between

NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED
as Network Rail

and

WEST MIDLANDS TRAINS LIMITED
as Train Operator

relating to the Track Access Contract (Passenger
Services) dated 15 May 2019

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THIS ELEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is dated 1st March 2022
and made

BETWEEN:

- (1) **NETWORK RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE LIMITED**, a company registered in England under number 2904587 having its registered office at Network Rail, 1 Eversholt Street, London NW1 2DN ("**Network Rail**"); and
- (2) **WEST MIDLANDS TRAINS LIMITED**, a company registered in England under number 09860466 having its registered office at 2nd Floor St Andrew's House, 18-20 St Andrew Street, London, United Kingdom, EC4A 3AG (the "**Train Operator**").

WHEREAS:

- (A) The parties entered into a Track Access Contract (Passenger Services) dated 15 May 2019 in a form approved by the Office of Rail and Road pursuant to Section 18 of the Railways Act 1993 ("**the Act**") hereafter referred to as the "**Contract**".
- (B) The parties now propose to enter into this Supplemental Agreement in order to amend the Contract as described herein.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1. **INTERPRETATION**

In this Supplemental Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (A) words and phrases defined in, and rules of interpretation set out in, the Contract shall have the same meaning and effect when used in this Supplemental Agreement; and
- (B) "Effective Date" means the date upon which the ORR issues its approval, pursuant to Section 22 of the Act, of the terms of this Supplemental Agreement.

2. **EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM**

The amendments to the Contract as set out in this Supplemental Agreement shall have effect from the Effective Date and shall cease to have effect on the Expiry Date or earlier termination of the Contract.

3. **AMENDMENTS TO SCHEDULE 5**

3.1 Table 2.1 (Passenger Train Slots) for Service Group EJ02 shall be deleted and replaced with the version set out as Appendix A to this Supplemental Agreement.

3.2 Table 4.1 (Additional Passenger Train Slots) for Service Group EJ02 shall be deleted and replaced with the version set out as Appendix B to this Supplemental Agreement

4. **GENERAL**

The parties agree that the Contract, as amended by this Supplemental Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms, and during the period in which the amendments made by this Supplemental Agreement are to have effect, all references in the Contract to “the contract” or, as the case may be, the “Agreement”, “herein”, “hereof”, “hereunder” and other similar expressions shall, unless the context requires otherwise, be read and construed as a reference to the Contract as amended by this Supplemental Agreement.

5. **THIRD PARTY RIGHTS**

No person who is not a party to this Supplemental Agreement shall have any right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce any term of this Supplemental Agreement.


6. **LAW**
