



## LEVEL CROSSINGS ACT 1983

### **THE NETWORK RAIL STOKE LEVEL CROSSING REVOCATION ORDER 2023**

Made on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023

Coming into force on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023

The Secretary of State for Transport, having been requested by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd (“the operator”) to make an Order under Section 1(5) of the Level Crossings Act 1983<sup>1</sup> (“the Act”) makes the following Order in exercise of his powers under the Act and of all other enabling powers, in accordance with the draft Order which accompanied the request subject to those modifications the Secretary of State thought fit to make.

1. This Order may be cited as The Network Rail Stoke Level Crossing Revocation Order 2023 and shall come into force on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
2. The British Railways Board (Hundred of Hoo Railway) (Stoke Level Crossing) Order 1972, The Railtrack Stoke Level Crossing Order 1999 and The Railtrack Stoke Level Crossing (Variation) Order 2001 are revoked.
